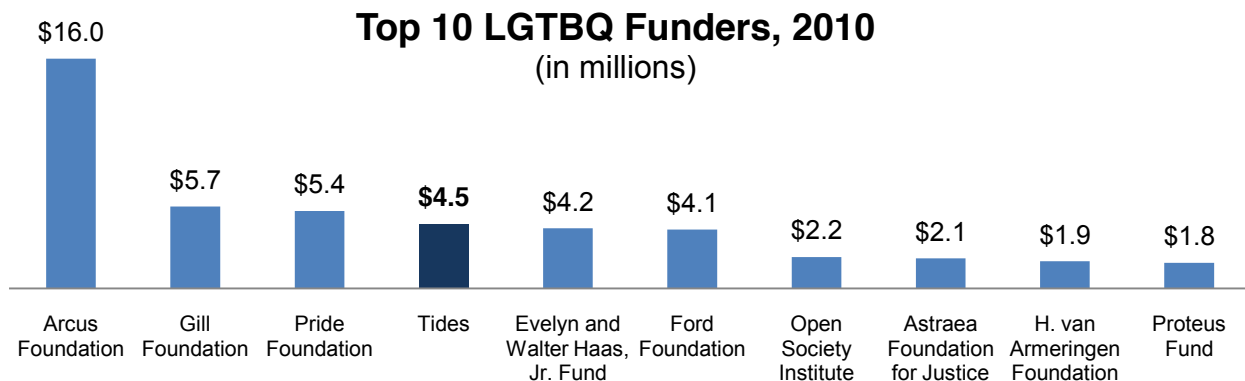


# Tides Fact Sheet: LGBTQ

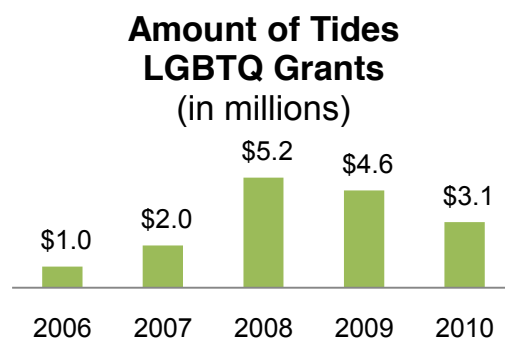
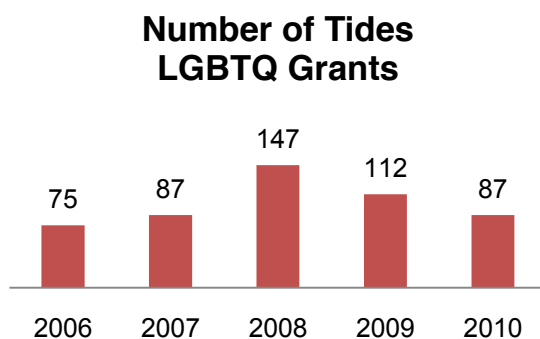

## Grantmaking



In terms of the amount of LGBTQ grants awarded in 2009, Tides (\$4.5M) ranked #4 of the nation's top ten LGBTQ funders, with the top three being foundations specifically focused on LGBTQ issues as their primary and/or only area of grantmaking.

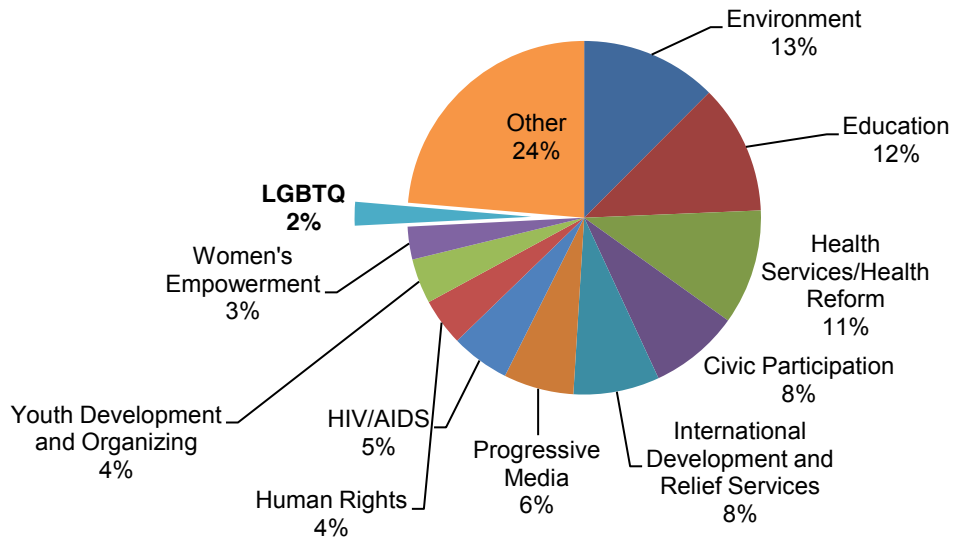
Tides LGBTQ grantmaking has fluctuated in the last five years: 75 grants/\$1M in 2006, to a peak of 147/\$5.2M in 2008, to the current 87/\$3.1M. The decrease is consistent with the LGBTQ funding field, as a whole (the decline in LGBTQ targeted funding decreased 12.7% from 2008 to 2009, compared to a 11.3% decrease from Tides during that same time period).



## Tides Fact Sheet: LGBTQ

- Tides has granted significantly in HIV/AIDS, with over 230 global grants totaling \$7.7M in 2010 to Africa, Asia, Central and South America, Europe and the United States.
- Grants to LGBTQ organizations and projects constituted \$3.1M (2%) of Tides total \$143M grantmaking in 2010. Tides awarded 87 grants representing 63 grantees and 20 funders in 15 countries, including Turkey, China, and nations of the former Soviet Union.

### Grantees

### Projects

- Of the 215 fiscally-sponsored projects of Tides, 4 (2%) focus specifically on LGBTQ work, though many more serve the LGBTQ community as part of a broader inclusive focus in health, community development and advocacy.
- LGBTQ projects of Tides include: Lavender Seniors of the East Bay, Face Value Project, National Queer Asian Pacific Islander Alliance (NQAPIA), and National Equality March/Equality Across America.

### Partners

- Significant LGBTQ partners of Tides: Out-of-Home Youth fund and field building project and International Treatment Preparedness Coalition (ITPC, formerly the HIV Collaborative) fund and project.
- Institutional funders of LGBTQ focused work include Elton John AIDS Foundation, Ford Foundation, Gill Foundation, Evelyn and Walter Haas, Jr. Fund, Open Society Institute, Levi Strauss Foundation, United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS, H. van Ameringen Foundation, and the World Health Organization.
- Tides has featured six LGBTQ speakers at the Momentum conferences, including Bishop Gene Robinson and Sahar Shafqat.
